### Learning options: (all within school terms)

- **Playgroups:** Our playgroup is aimed at helping non-Chinese background families with their interest in learning Mandarin. We will make the learning full of fun with storytelling, songs, rhymes and games.  
**Tuesdays:** from 3.20 pm to 4.45 pm at the Franklin Early Childhood School Community Room.  
**Thursdays:** from 3.20 pm to 4.45 pm at the West Belconnen Child and Family Centre, Kippax Place, Holt.  
**Saturdays:** from 9.30 am to 11.00 am at the West Belconnen Child and Family Centre, Kippax Place, Holt.
- **Private Family Immersion lesson:** a short private family immersion course is also available which is created to fit into individual family needs and time slot. Further information can be discussed per request.
- **Radio Program:** we also volunteer to host a Mandarin Language program at 2XX radio station, 98.3FM every Friday evening from 7.00 to 7.30 pm, where we showcase our Mandarin for Fun program on air to make the learning curve easier for anyone who wants to be involved in learning Chinese.
